## How do you register for this credentialing process?

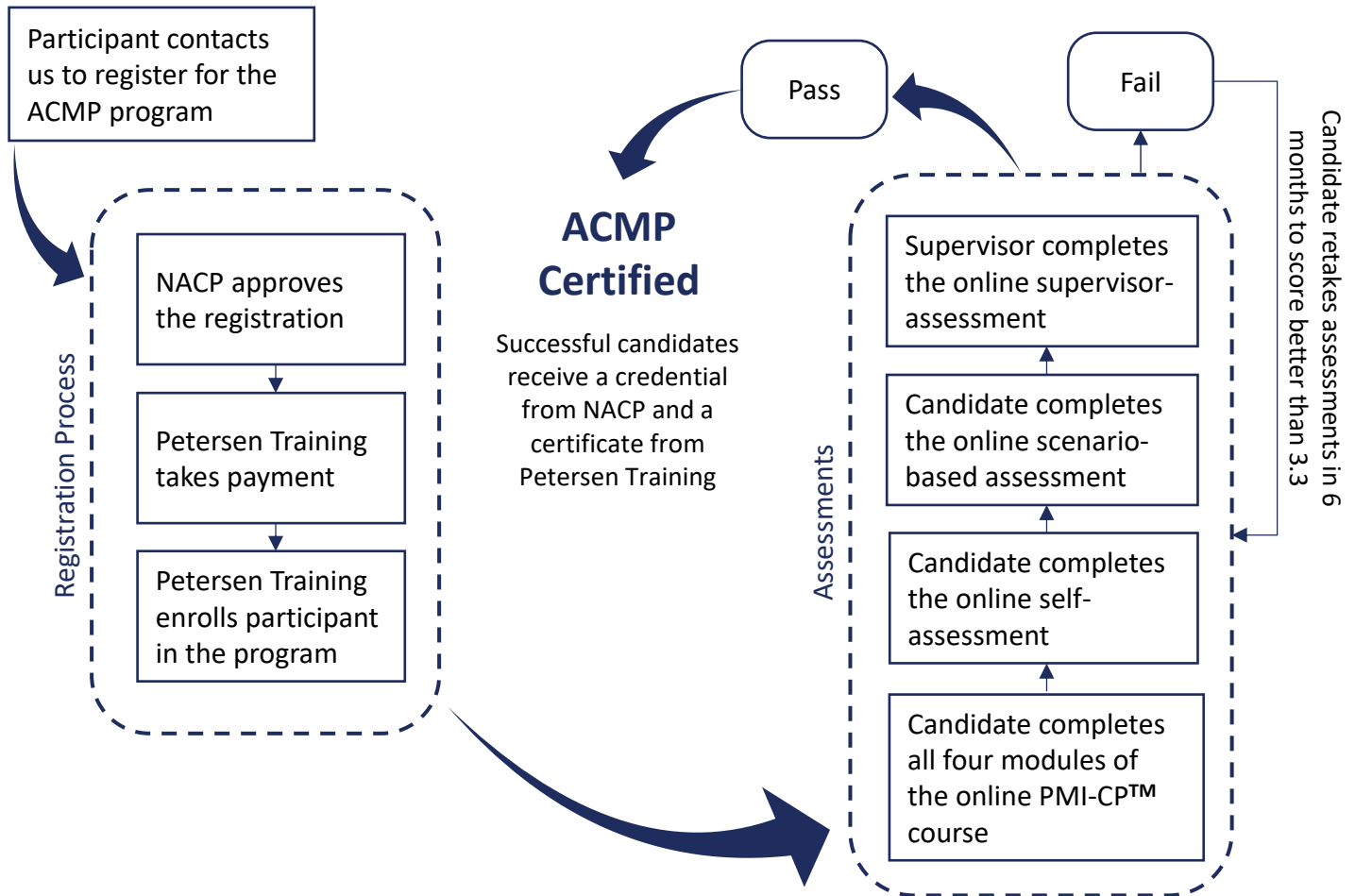
This credentialing program is based on the **NACP Construction Management Professional Standard** and **PMI® Construction Professional (PMI-CP™)** content. Participants were introduced to NACP standards while obtaining BCMP certification. They are introduced to PMI-CP™ content and standards during an online course within this program.

### ACMP Details...

This **program is built in an online self-paced format**. The first step in the program is for participants to finish an online PMI-CP™ course with four modules. Participants are NOT required to sit for the PMI-CP™ exam to earn the NACP ACMP credential—they are only required to prove that they have completed the online course (however, as a bonus, they will also be prepared to sit for the PMI-CP™ exam on their own). After they finish the online course, participants complete three online NACP assessments: 1) a self-assessment, 2) a scenario-based assessment, and 3) a supervisor assessment. Participants receive a comprehensive assessment report that covers their overall performance in these assessments. **Those who complete the PMI-CP™ course and score better than a 3.3 aggregate score on the assessments will receive the ACMP credential.** Those who do not achieve this score must wait 6 months after receipt of the final report to retake the assessments (at a cost of \$200).

## Our training and assessment process...

The following diagram provides a visual depiction of the training and assessment process for the ACMP credential:



### Who should pursue the ACMP?

This credentialing process is for those who have at least two years of experience leading construction teams. It is specifically designed to help construction managers receive an overall assessment of their strengths and weaknesses, while also showing their value to their company leadership. This credential will help those who obtain it to differentiate themselves when seeking positions of higher responsibility.

### Benefits for my company?

This program provides significant benefits for your company. The first of these is standardization of terms and processes. The second is increased knowledge and skills of construction management team members. The third, and most important, benefit is the ability of your company to list your credentials in proposals—to set them apart from the competition when pursuing future construction work.
