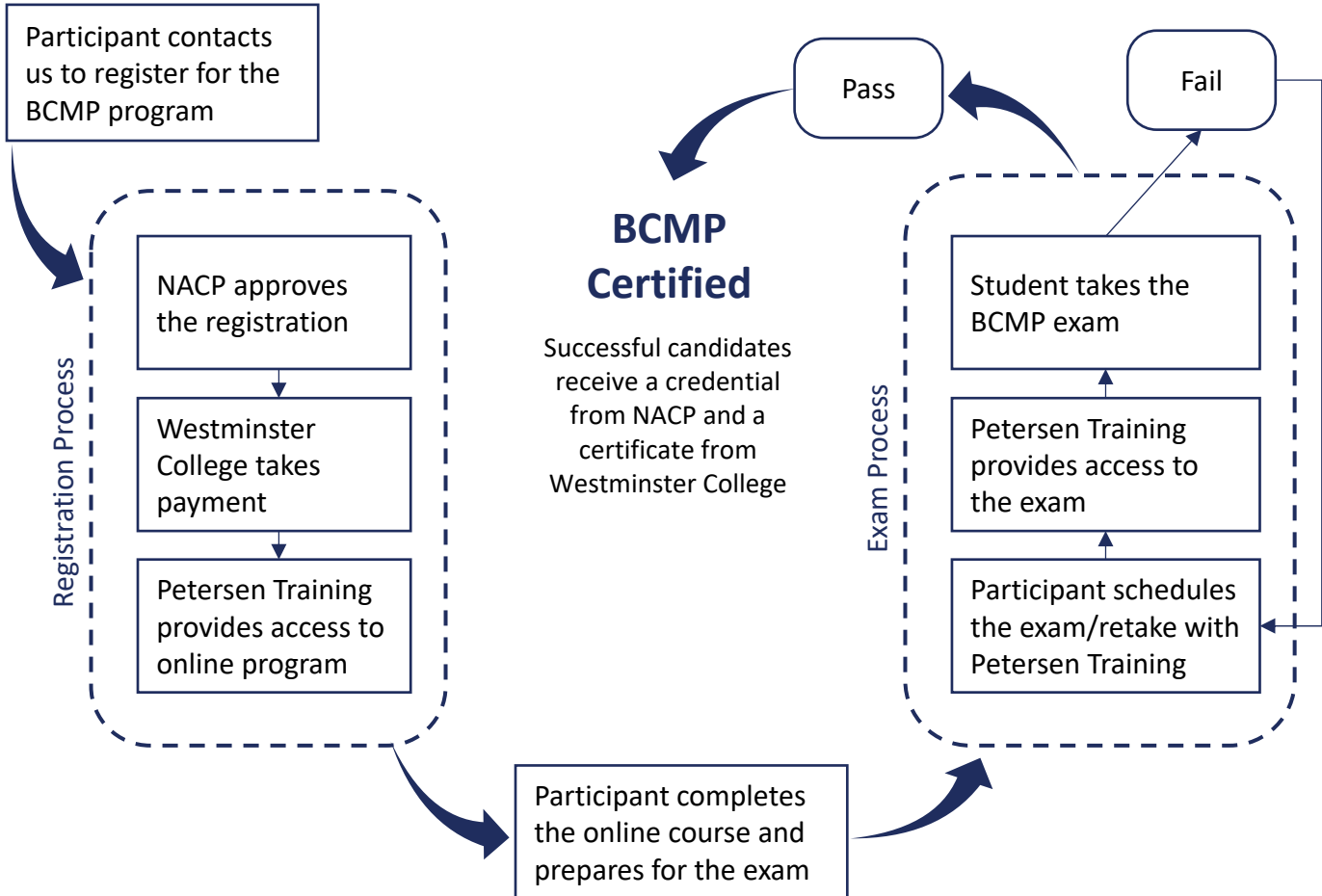
This credentialing program is based on the **NACP Construction Management Professional Standard**. Participants should study this standard until they feel that they are ready to take the certification exam. Those who successfully pass the exam will be awarded the **BCMP** credential by the NACP and will receive a certificate of completion from Westminster College.

BCMP Exam Details...

When students are ready to take the exam, Petersen Training will register them to take a 200 question, 4-hour exam, to assess their understanding of the topics shown above. A candidate must achieve a passing score of 70% to receive the BCMP credential. Candidates who do not achieve this score can retake the exam two more times (at a price of \$200 for each retest) during the 6 month period that follows their first exam. If a candidate does not pass during one of these attempts, he or she will be required to wait 6 months after his or her last exam in order to be eligible to sit for the exam again. We are committed to helping all participants through this process!

Who should pursue the BCMP?
